

Bernard Crick Awards for Outstanding Teaching

In honour of Professor Sir Bernard Crick, the Political Studies Association names two annual awards for outstanding teaching: one award open to all lecturers and another award for an outstanding new entrant to the profession.



Each year nominations are invited from departments for the Main Prize and New Entrant Prize, to be awarded at the following Political Studies Association's Annual Conference

Rules

- Nominees and nominators must be members of the Political Studies Association
- The New Entrant Prize is open to any member who has served not more than three years in a full time lecturing post on either a contract or permanent basis
- No restriction is made on the number of nominees from individual Departments
- The signatures of three Political Studies Association members must support nominations
- Nominations must be made on the relevant form , accompanied by a Statement of Case on not more than 3 sides of A4 which identifies and provides supporting evidence of: innovation in teaching, commendation from student evaluation, and commendation from peer review/external observation
- Other supporting material may include evidence of training in teaching methods involving a portfolio and any relevant publications
- Nominations should be submitted in electronic format to psa@ncl.ac.uk

The dates for submission of nominations will be advertised in the PSA e letters, PSA Newsletter and on the website nearer the date.
