The PSA will cover the full costs of members wishing to use the Stepping Stones Nursery during 15 – 17 April 2019.

Situated close to the Nottingham Conference Centre, the Stepping Stones Nursery provides facilities for **children aged 6 weeks to 5 years** (https://www.steppingstonesltd.com/nursery-rooms/).

Sessions run from 07.45 -13.00 and 13.00 -18.00.

CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY:

- You must be a **current member of the Political Studies Association** and have been a member for over one calendar year.
- Funding is only available to PSA members who book in advance.
- Stepping Stones Nursery requires placement details at least a month ahead of the conference and so the deadline to be considered for funding is Monday 18th March 2019.
- Should there be a high demand for places these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and cannot be booked onsite at the conference venue. If the nursery becomes fully booked the PSA will meet members' childcare costs with other providers at the same level of funding (Day Rate: £52; Half day AM/PM Sessions: £31.50 each, running from 7.45-13.00 / 13.00-18.00).
