Submitting your video entry to this year’s competition is really easy, but it does require you to follow a few important steps.

Once you’ve made your final edits and have the video file ready, please e-mail us at josh.niderost@psa.ac.uk so that we can create a unique upload folder on the internet for your school. In this folder you should also include a team photo and a picture of the school’s logo.

In addition to this, please make sure you or your teacher completes the following online form for each video entry [here](#). The information entered into this form will help us with our shortlisting and students are asked to submit a short paragraph about their video.

As previous years, you can submit more than one video per school. However, please name the files clearly and submit a [separate form](#) for each entry.

This year we want to upload all entries onto the PSA website, showcasing all of your ideas, skills and talents.

The deadline for submissions is Friday 21 October and short listed teams will be notified thereafter.



Competition Guidelines:

- Teams should consist of no fewer than two and no more than five students.
- Entrants are encouraged to think creatively and to adopt a broad approach that challenges dominant assumptions or offers new perspectives.
- Short-listed teams will be invited to a meeting at the Houses of Parliament in early November 2016 to discuss

the ideas presented in their video with a jury consisting of politicians, journalists, pollsters and academics.

- Travel and accommodation will be provided for the winning team and their teacher in a central London hotel for the PSA’s Awards Ceremony on Nov. 29th 2016.
- **The deadline for submissions is Friday 21 October, 2016.**
