Scope

Word length

Submitted articles should be no more than 9,000 words in length *including* all notes and references. Shorter research notes are also welcome but regretfully we do not have space to accommodate responses to published articles.

Title, short title and abstract

Please provide a fully descriptive article title of not more than 40 words and an abstract of up to 150 words.

Keywords

Between 3 and 5 keywords should be provided for the article.

Submit online

To upload a manuscript, please prepare the following files:

- 1 An abstract of no more than 150 words
- 2 A title page with names and affiliations of all authors
- 3 The article with any references to the identity of the authors (for example, in acknowledgements, headers, footers or in the reference list) removed to allow for double-blind peer review
